Key Facts



Guinea worm disease is set to be the first human parasitic disease ever to be wiped out – and the first to be eradicated without the use of a vaccine or medicine.



For more than two decades, the UAE has been a major partner in the Guinea worm eradication campaign.



This contribution began with a financial commitment made by the late Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan (may God rest his soul) in 1990.



The Latin name for Guinea worm disease, Dracunculus medinensis, literally means 'Little dragon from Medina'. This refers to the burning sensation caused by Guinea worm – and how it once plagued the holy city of Medina.



Female Guinea worms can grow up to 1 meter in length in the human body, before they emerge through a painful blister.



At the peak of the eradication effort, village volunteers were operating in more than 23,000 African villages.



Since the 2014 start of the UAE polio program in Pakistan, the cases of polio related child paralysis have dropped 82% – from over 300 cases of polio-related child paralysis in 2014 to just three in 2017.
